

## Summer Camp Camp Worker

**POSITION TYPE:** Part Time/Full Time/Substitute

### **EMPLOYMENT**

**CLASSIFICATION:** Non-Exempt

**RELATIONSHIPS:** Reports directly to the Summer Camp Director and to the Principal of MCCA. Works directly with other Summer Camp employees. Works with parents, students, and community members weekly.

**PURPOSE:** The successful candidate for this position will be able to fulfill all driving (as applicable) and supervision duties assigned by the Summer Camp Director

### **REQUIRED SPIRITUAL QUALITIES**

It is expected that the Driver/Camp Worker will:

- Acknowledge Christ as Savior and seek to live life as His disciple.
- Believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative, inerrant Word of God—our standard for faith and practice.
- Believe and actively support the school's statement of faith.
- Demonstrate a desire for spiritual growth as evidenced by his or her prayer life, Bible study, and spiritual outreach to others.
- Be a Christian role model in attitude, speech, and actions toward others (Luke 6:40). This includes being committed to God's biblical standards for sexual conduct.
- Evidence of the fruit of the Spirit and biblical principles in dealing with people.
- Actively participate in a local evangelical church.

### **REQUIRED PROFESSIONAL QUALITIES**

It is expected that the Driver/Camp Worker will:

- Possess a current CDL that enables them to drive a school bus for daily Summer Camp trips (applicable to Driver only applicants).

- Show up on time and come to work as assigned. Excessive absences are not permissible. **If you are unable to make your scheduled shift, contact the Camp Director immediately.**
- Be aware of safety guidelines of Summer Camp and be willing to receive both positive and negative criticism as it relates to job performance.

### **REQUIRED PERSONAL QUALITIES**

It is expected that the Driver/Camp Worker will:

- Possess a Christ-like disposition and demonstrate a love for working in a Christian school and a love for serving others.
- View their daily duties as an act of worship and take ownership over their daily tasks.
- Meet everyday stress with emotional stability, objectivity, and optimism.

### **SUMMER CAMP RESPONSIBILITIES**

It is expected that the Driver/Camp Worker will:

#### ***General Duties***

- Will teach the assigned curriculum/ devotion to their students to the best of their ability.
- **Be flexible** to accommodate unanticipated alterations to the daily schedule so as to serve the greater good.
- Attend to the duty assigned to them by the Summer Camp Director and/or Principal.
- Deliver devotions to students on a daily basis- to the BEST of their ability.
- Keep their bus organized, clean, and presentable.
- Help maintain classroom cleanliness which will involve: sweeping and mopping daily, and taking out the trash.
- Be a positive force and influence in the lives of all of our students at Summer Camp.
